

CARROLL COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND, INC.

Scholarship Guidelines

1. Scholarships are not necessarily annual, but are to be awarded in years determined by the Board of Directors. The amount and number of scholarships is to be decided by the Board.
2. Scholarships are available to any individual planning to attend or attending any post secondary school. The individual must be majoring in a field related to Agriculture.
3. The scholarship recipient(s) will be chosen in a manner determined by the Board of Directors. Applications shall be completed and returned by March of each year with a copy of academic records.
4. Applicants must be a resident of Carroll County, however, they do not need to attend high school in Carroll County.
5. All Scholarship funds will be used for tuition only, and will be sent directly to the school at the beginning of the second semester.
6. The Scholarship(s) must be used within one year of its grant. A Scholarship recipient not continuing his or her education in Agriculture will not receive the Scholarship.
7. It is hoped that this Scholarship will be in addition to any other financial aid. There is no certain grade point that has to be kept once the Scholarship is paid.
8. If he or she is forced to quit for reasons beyond their control, (for example death, illness, etc.) the Board of Directors will review the case and make a decision concerning repayment.
9. Scholarship applications must be returned to the Carroll County Chamber of Commerce office by March of the year applying, no exceptions.
