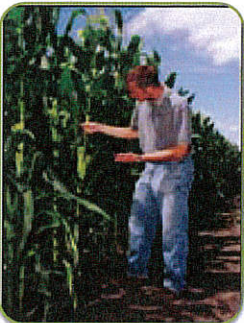
Operational Internship

Individuals will be responsible for assisting local AGRILAND FS facility in agronomy or energy operations, as seasonal needs demand. Individual will experience a variety of responsibilities related to the delivery, storage, and maintenance related to the products and services supplied by the location. Individuals will gain experience working in a fast paced, high demanding environment with the ability to make a difference for the customers' serviced by the location. This entry-level internship will allow individuals the opportunity to grow into additional roles as they continue with their education.



Administrative Internship (*Indianola, IA only*)

Individuals will assist within the business administrative / accounting departments, working with a team to accomplish clerical and customer service responsibilities. Individuals will learn new computer, communication, and customer service skills in a fast paced environment.



Crop Scouting Internship

Individual will monitor assigned crops throughout a 10-12 week spring and summer growing season. Using integrated pest management and good agronomy skills, crop scouts produce written reports for customers and agronomy team to communicate and share information about the quality of the growing crop. Based on the scouts' recommendations, customers may choose treatment options to reduce yield loss. Scouts receive excellent training and meet once a week to review and practice agronomy skills.
